Nyadire United Methodist Hospital and Orphanage - Zimbabwe, Africa

The hospital is located in a rural area of Zimbabwe, Africa. The hospital serves a community of 60,000 people. The building is over 80 years old and in need of repairs. Due to shortage of medications, medical supplies, and equipment some sick people no longer come because the hospital can't help them. Staff includes 1 doctor/superintendent and 100 support persons including nurses. More than 1,000 babies are delivered annually. St Paul's will continue to support this ministry.

Health kits contain basic hygiene supplies-- items we take for granted, yet depend on to maintain our health: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, washcloth, handtowel, comb, fingernail clippers or nail file, and bandages. It doesn't seem like much-- but it is a welcome gift for someone who doesn't have even these basic supplies. It can mean the difference between maintaining health and contracting or spreading disease.
