*The **Wholeness and Healing Service** is a special time set aside the second Sunday of each month to bring needs for physical, spiritual, or emotional healing before God. A short meditation and scripture are presented by a lay person who leads the service, after which each person whose name is on St. Paul's extended prayer list is lifted by name and prayed for by the group. The pastor leads us in communion, and prays privately with anyone who needs individual time. A highlight of the service is the blessing and presentation of prayer quilts to the families for whom they have been hung. We sing a few familiar hymns, the setting is quiet and informal, and the service is usually over in less than an hour. All are welcome, whether to pray privately for your own needs, or to pray for those on our list who have requested prayers.*
