PRAYER QUILTS

Our Prayers and Squares Ministry provides quilts for any person in physical, emotional, or spiritual crisis who feels they can benefit from being "covered in prayer." A heavy thread is stitched through quilt layers and the ends are left free to be tied with a square knot. As each knot is tied, a silent prayer is said for the person in need. These quilts are a statement of faith and a testimony to our belief in God and the power of prayer. We are thankful for our vibrant prayer quilt ministry, which continues during our closure. Since the congregation cannot be here to tie knots on the quilts in person, the pastors and staff will tie knots on them regularly with freshly washed hands, representing the faithful prayers of the congregation.
