

Church Nursery Guidelines

Procedures for Drop-off

Sign-In, leave a cell phone number and all requested information.

Please leave diaper bag, snacks, and drinks for children labeled with child's name.

Please share allergies, and special needs with the nursery workers every time you drop off a child in the nursery.

Families must remain in the church and be available at all times while a child is in nursery care.

Please limit time a child is in the nursery to a timeframe of less than 3 hours.

Families must pick up their own children or let nursery workers know at drop-off who will be picking up children.

Families will be called and asked to return to the nursery for children under the following circumstances:

- After 10 minutes of crying families will be called.
- Families will be called if children display cold or fever symptoms.
- We practice compassionate redirection. If a child's behavior can not be corrected after 3 warnings and a time out, we will seek family guidance for help with behavior concerns.
